Here is some language to enter claims regarding the holding of turns for rest when the employee did not earn his rest on that assignment.

Allow 130.0 miles basic day code MC account turn (WE01 or SE01) was improperly held out of proper rotation in the Aurora to Lacrosse pool or Aurora to Savanna pool. This turn was held 1st out in the pool while I obtained legal rest for service I did not perform on said turn to earn this rest. This mishandling resulted in lost earnings due to the fact I am entitled to difference in earnings-make whole for the service performed versus my assignments earnings. This claim is due under my Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) and the holding of my turn first out while following pool turns ran around me unfairly reduced the total earning potential of my turn.

Allow 130.0 miles code MC account 1st out rested engineer on Engineer Extra-Board when crew office unilaterally chose to bypass turn (AUIWE01 or AUISE01) in it's proper pool rotation. Turn (AUIWE01 or AUISE01) should have been called on train ( train symbol on duty time and date). Turn ?????? Properly stood for this service under existing 1st in 1st out pool handling rule, this turn should have been properly used in rotation with the 1st out available extra-board employee. I was denied a work opportunity and therefore a basic day due.
